Thank you for everything you did last week: helping your child navigate Teams, emailing me back work, videos and pictures of your children, the friendly and encouraging messages... I appreciate all of you as we navigate this time together. I am hoping that your family is getting into somewhat of a routine and the work provided is a fit for your family. This week will be similar to last week:

- Math and Language Arts assignment. They are found emailed with this newsletter, under my name on the school website or posted in TEAMS. These are the must-do's for the week and will be used for my assessment and reporting. Please make sure these are handed in every week no later than Friday evening either by email or putting on TEAMS. (either mode works for me!) **The Ministry is requiring teachers to provide assessment and year-end report cards during this time. It is very difficult for me to assess your child if I don't receive the weekly activities back. Thank you for your help with this!** If your child is on Teams, I will be giving them feedback on their work in their Chat feature (top icon on the left hand side) after I have looked at it. If they are not on Teams, I will email you the feedback to pass along to your child. Remember if you do not have a printer, your child can just use a piece of paper for their work.
- Team Meetings this week will take place on TUESDAY at 9am and THURSDAY at 2pm. Hoping to see your child at one of them, but if that doesn't work for your family, that's ok too! 😊 I am also going to be reading a story on WEDNESDAY at 9am if your child is around for that (pajamas and bedhead are encouraged!).
- I am hoping that you can sign up your child for a free account with Epic books (an email will be send to you with directions). This is a resource I will be using for some of our Language Arts lessons in the future. It is an on-line library similar to Raz-Kids with access to thousands of books.
- Choice board if your child would like to complete any or all of the activities. I love seeing pictures of these too!

- Mrs.Bentley (our librarian) has posted a weekly read-aloud in our Language Arts Team.
- I will continue to put daily prompts in the Teams folders for students who are wanting to leave comments.

Hoping to wave to many of you when you come pick up your child's supplies on Monday! If your child is missing something in their bag or has something that does not belong to them, we will try to sort it out when we meet again. **Your child will have their JumpMath book in their bag and in the future, I will be using these for part of their math practice at home, so please keep it in a safe place to access down the road.** Thanks!
