Monday, May 25 th	Making Words: This sound has 3 letters that makes up one sound "igh." How many words can you think of that rhyme with "light" (ex: bright etc.)
Tuesday, May 26 th	Read & Respond: Read a book on Raz Kids/Epic Books (or a book from home) and tell someone about your favourite part and explain why. (Does it make you feel happy? What does it make you wonder?)
Wednesday, May 27 th	Quick Write: Choose a topic to write about (your choice) and write a paragraph that includes a topic sentence (introducing the story) and includes at least 3 details. Wrap up your story using your topic sentence again (rewritten in different words). Topic Example: My dog is the best pet or Riding a bike is the best exercise.
Thursday, May 28 th	Playing with Words: Get out your favourite book or poem and get ready for a long vowel hunt! (long vowels say their name "a, e, i, o, u"). How many long vowels can you find? What is making the sound? (Ex: ai, ie, oa, ie etc.)
Friday, May 29 th	Fluency: Read a poem or part of a story with another person, try to say the words at the same time (choral read). Then read the story again as an echo read (I read one line, you read one line).
