Date	Activity
Monday, May 18th	Happy Victoria Day 😊
Tuesday, May 19th	Read & Respond: Read a book on Raz Kids/Epic Books (or a book from home) and think about how the main character’s feelings change throughout the story. How many feelings/emotions can you identify? (angry, sad, happy etc.) Tell someone what they are.
Wednesday, May 20th	Quick Write: If you were a superhero what could you do, what would your power be, how could you help the world and what would your superhero name be? Write a response and use at least 4 sentences to explain.
Thursday, May 21st	Playing with Words: The long “a” sound can be made many different ways: ai, ay, ae (Ex: <u>s</u> ai <u>l</u> , <u>s</u> ay, <u>c</u> ake). Can you think of two words for each? Can you think of more? Hint: “ay” is usually at the end of the word, “ai” is usually in the middle and “ae” is at the end of a word with that magic “e”
Friday, May 22nd	Fluency: Read a poem or part of a story using your regular voice, your angry/growly voice and your excited voice.

Date	Activity
Monday, May 18th	Happy Victoria Day 😊
Tuesday, May 19th	Expanded Form: Change the expanded form of these number to standard form (ex: $30 + 5 = 35$) Numbers: $(200 + 30 + 4)$ $(500 + 60 + 7)$ $(600 + 9)$ $(400 + 30)$
Wednesday, May 20th	Real-World: Head outside and make a pattern with natural materials (rocks, sticks etc.) Make these patterns: AB, ABC, AABB, ABCB
Thursday, May 21st	Skip Counting: Skip count by 10 forwards and backwards to 100. Start at different numbers on the hundreds board (Ex: 12, 23, 33 etc.). Hint: When you count by 10's you go down the column in your 100's chart)
Friday, May 22nd	Word Problem: Solve this problem. There are 100 leaves on a tree. The wind blows 35 leaves off. Write a number sentence to show how many leaves are left on the tree.
