Monday, May 18 <sup>th</sup>	Happy Victoria Day 🕲
Tuesday, May 19 <sup>th</sup>	<b>Read &amp; Respond:</b> Read a book on Raz Kids/Epic Books (or a book from home) and think about how the main character's feelings change throughout the story. How many feelings/emotions can you identify? (angry, sad, happy etc.) Tell someone what they are.
Wednesday, May 20 <sup>th</sup>	Quick Write: If you were a superhero what could you do, what would your power be, how could you help the world and what would your superhero name be? Write a response and use at least 4 sentences to explain.
Thursday, May 21 <sup>st</sup>	<ul> <li>Playing with Words: The long "a" sound can be made many different ways: ai, ay, ae (Ex: sail, say, cake). Can you think of two words for each? Can you think of more?</li> <li>Hint: "ay" is usually at the end of the word, "ai" is usually in the middle and "ae" is at the end of a word with that magic "e"</li> </ul>

Monday, May 18 <sup>th</sup>	Happy Victoria Day 🐵
<b>Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup></b>	Expanded Form: Change the expanded form of these number to standard form (ex: 30 + 5 = 35) Numbers: (200 + 30 + 4) (500 + 60 + 7) (600 + 9) (400 + 30)
Wednesday, May 20 <sup>th</sup>	<b>Real-World:</b> Head outside and make a pattern with natural materials (rocks, sticks etc.) Make these patterns: AB, ABC, AABB, ABCB
Thursday, May 21 <sup>st</sup>	<b>Skip Counting:</b> Skip count by 10 forwards and backwards to 100. Start at different numbers on the hundreds board (Ex: 12, 23, 33 etc.). <b>Hint:</b> When you count by 10's you go down the column in your 100's chart)
