## May 2023 in Review

- DPAC April General Meeting Minutes emailed. Some items to note:
- Discussed PAC role as advocacy not fundraising. An operating norms document is expected by September 2023.
- Food Affordability program happening next year, BCCPAC wants this distinction. This year's Affordability Fun is not confirmed to carry over. Even if carried over, there may be new rules or less funds. PAC should be informed by the Principal how much \$ is left. DPAC recommends spending all funds this year, including; gift cards, supplies, and field trips. Some schools will give families $\$ 500-1 \mathrm{~K}$ gift cards to help with food security during Summer. Only $\$ 400 \mathrm{~K}$ has been spent of the 1.5 M as of February. We can even request more funds if needed.
- Principals need to review IEPs by May/June. Typically previous years IEP continues through September, then updated October/November, new IEP starts in December.
- FYI there was a directive from Action4Canada to "infiltrate PACs" in March. This is a group that is very upset about certain learning resources and SOGI in our schools. Be sure to verify people are students' parents/guardians.
