Indigenous Education Success Grant

Last year at this time, staff, students, and families were invited to give their voice in our application for our annual Indigenous Education Success Grant.

The focus of our application was around language in the following areas:

- The co-naming of our school
- Learning place names and the story behind the names
- Building up our classroom libraries with more Indigenous authors and stories
- Creating outdoor learning opportunities that weave language, culture and history together

Over the past year, we have worked with our community to co-name our school, had a new logo designed – see top of page (thank you to Jay Roberts), and we have built up our classroom library collections. Our staff continue to include outdoor learning as part of their regular weekly schedules. We have had guest speakers into our school to teach us about place names and the stories those names hold.
